

The Lion Leintwardine

We are open daily from 9am serving food between the following hours –
Monday to Saturday: 12 – 2.30pm / dinner 5 – 8.30pm. Last orders for drinks are 11pm
Sunday: 12 – 6pm. Last orders for drinks are 10pm. Tables can be booked by phone, email or via our website.

We wanted to let you know of some important changes we have made to ensure the safety of our guests and staff because of Covid19. We ask you to read through the following before you arrive, so you know how we are operating.

We are currently adhering to government guidelines and able to take table bookings for inside and outside. Tables can be booked inside for up to six people from any number of households or a group of any size but only from two households and booking outside can be made up to 30 people outside from any number of households. Children of any age are included in these numbers. We will be operating strictly table service only.

To ensure staggered arrival times for all our guests please arrive promptly at your allocated booking time. This way we can ensure safe distancing for yourself and other guests, this also allows us to take you to your table quickly and keep queuing to a minimum. Your booking allows you 2 ¾ hour at your table.

Face coverings must always be worn during your visit unless you are seated at a table.

We have reduced the number of tables to allow more space between guests and because of this if you have booked a table outside and the weather changes, we can't guarantee that we could offer you a table inside and vice versa for tables booked inside.

Please be aware of the Government's required social distancing rules and respect the distance between yourselves and our staff and other customers.

When arriving we ask you enter only at the front door and to wait for a member of staff to take you to your table, please sanitise your hands on the way into the pub. There are hand sanitiser dispensers positioned throughout the premises.

It is best to pre-book before arriving at the Lion, if you do not have a booking we will try to find a table for you but this may not be possible, and you may be asked to queue away from the building.

All our staff are trained to maintain good hygiene and hands are washed or sanitised after each contact with the public. Staff will always be wearing face coverings .

To reduce contact risk, we will be wrapping cutlery in disposable napkins and delivering them with your food.

We wanted to reassure you that care and consideration has gone into spacing the distance between the tables and positioning of the chairs so please refrain from moving tables and benches, either inside or in the garden.

Menus will only be used once, and the paper recycled afterwards.

Our bar will remain closed to customers, all drinks orders and payments will be taken at the table.

We want to reassure you that the pub will be regularly cleaned. Our tables will be sanitised after each customer. We will maintain the highest cleaning standards in all areas.

Toilets will be regularly cleaned and operating on a one in one out system, we have an individual disabled toilet for those not wishing to share public space in the ladies and gents' toilets. These will be cleaned and sanitised frequently.

Children are as always welcome but please do not let them wander away from your table. We are sorry but the children's play area will remain closed for the time being. Dogs are still welcome in our garden and top bar but must be kept on a tight lead.

We will be asking for contact details from each person or household the table to conform to the governments track and trace scheme. These details will be kept safe for 21 days after your visit and then destroyed.

Myself and my team look forward to welcoming you to the Lion and we hope you will enjoy your visit with the confidence of knowing your safety and health is our top priority.
